10:30 Call to order and Pledge of Allegiance

10:30 Executive Session pursuant to C.R.S. §24-6-402 (4) (f) (I) for personnel matters regarding the conducting of interviews for the Public Health Director position

The Board of Lincoln County Commissioners met at 10:30 a.m. on June 12, 2018. The following attended: Chairman Doug Stone, Commissioners Ed Schiffers and Steve Burgess, and County Administrator Jacob Piper. Clerk to the Board Corinne M. Lengel was absent and excused.

Chairman Stone called the meeting to order.

Mr. Burgess made a motion to go into executive session, per 24-6-402 (4) (f) (I), C.R.S., for personnel matters regarding interviewing for the Public Health Director position. Mr. Schiffers second the motion, which carried unanimously. Those remaining for the session were Mr. Stone, Mr. Schiffers, Mr. Burgess, Mr. Piper, and the applicant. The executive session was recorded, and the recording will remain on file in the County Clerk's vault for the statutory ninety days.

Upon coming out of executive session, the Board discussed the potential to negotiate sharing a public health director with Elbert County. After deciding that they wanted to keep the position solely in Lincoln County, Mr. Burgess made a motion to offer the Public Health Director position to Jobeth Mills at thirty-five hours a week, for a six month trial period. It was also stated that the Board will allow Mrs. Mills to tentatively complete her thirty-five hours a week by working three 9 hour days and one 8 hour day per week. Mr. Schiffers seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. Mr. Stone contacted Mrs. Mills who accepted the job.

With no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Stone adjourned the meeting until 9:00 a.m. on June 18, 2018.
